STATEMENT OF OBJECTION

[Carefully Read the Enclosed Notice of Pending and Proposed Settlement of Class Action]

If you feel that the proposed settlement is unfair (although agreeing with the filing of the suit) because you feel the terms of the settlement are inadequate or otherwise unfair, then you should not opt-out but should file an objection thereby notifying the Court of the objection to the settlement provisions. If you have an objection to the settlement, you must fill out this form and return it to the Clerk of Court by **December 15, 2008**. If you follow these requirements, you may appear at the hearing to have your objection heard by the Court and present any evidence you may have. If you fail to follow these requirements, you may attend the hearing, but you will not be permitted to raise any objections to the proposed Settlement. The number that object and the reasons for objection will be considered by the Court at the hearing on whether the proposed settlement should be considered and given final approval.

You may make an objection to the settlement and file a Proof of Claim for a refund.

In order to qualify to make an objection, you must own or have owned a piece of property upon which you paid the special assessment for EMS (ambulance) services on or after March 31, 1999.

Please list the street address and the property identification (I.D.) number for the property on which you paid the assessment. The property identification (I.D.) number can be found as part of your address on the envelope this form came in.
