**PROOF OF CLAIM**

If you filled out the Election To Opt-Out, you are not eligible to request a refund. Do not complete this refund request.

In order to qualify to receive a refund, you must own or have owned a piece of property upon which you paid the special assessment for EMS (ambulance) services on or after March 31, 1999. If you qualify and want to receive a refund as part of this settlement, you must fill out, date, sign and return this Proof of Claim form to the Clerk of Court by December 15, 2008.

If you own more than one piece of property that is eligible for a refund, you should file a separate proof of claim for each property. If you qualify for a refund and are the current owner of the property, the refund will be a credit against the County's assessment of next year's ad valorem taxes upon that property. If you no longer own the property, a refund check will be mailed to you at the address you provide below. Only those property owners that paid the 1998 special assessment on the last day (March 31, 1999) or after it was past due are eligible to check the first box below (very few will be eligible)

If you qualify for a refund and do not return this Proof of Claim at all or do not mail it to the Clerk of Court for filing by December 15, 2008, you will not receive any refund.

Please list the street address and the property identification (I.D.) number for the property on which you paid the assessment. The property identification (I.D.) number can be found as part of your address on the envelope this form came in.
